This matter is an appeal from the Election Administrator's decision 2001 EAD 88, issued January 23, 2001, in the Office of the Election Administrator's Case Nos. E010811MI, E0108113MI and E0108114MI. An appeal was requested by Robert Horvath, a member of Teamsters Local Union 372 in Detroit, Michigan.

A hearing was held before me on January 30, 2001. The following people were heard by way of teleconference: Jeffery J. Ellison, Esq. and Lois Tuttle for the Election Administrator's Office; Mr. Horvath; Mr. Dennis Romanowski, one of the protestors and a member of Local Union 372; and Mr. Alan Derey, one of the protestors and a member of Local Union 372. No further submission were received on this matter.

I have read the papers and considered the arguments made at the hearing. I am without the authority to modify or change the Rules, and do not believe that even if I had such authority under the Consent Decree and the Rules these circumstances warrant a departure of the equitable application of these Rules. Therefore the decision of the Election Administrator as to the ineligibility of Mr. Horvath is affirmed in all respects.
