
A pre-election protest was timely filed pursuant to Article XI, §1 of the Rules for the IBT International Union Delegate and Officer Election, revised August 1, 1990 ("Rules"). In this protest Brian Barclay contends that the Rules have been violated because the Local Union posted the list of nominees in such a manner that more prominence is given the slate headed by Secretary-Treasurer Ed Mireles. He contends further that Mr. Mireles (1) changed the name of the Mireles posted slate; (2) added the name of Gloria Geyer to the Mireles slate despite the fact that she failed to sign the slate declaration form; and (3) rearranged the names of the candidates on both slates.

Subsequent to the filing of the protest, at the suggestion of the Regional Coordinator, Geraldine Leshin, Mr. Mireles reposted the nominations slate in a format that is acceptable to Mr. Barclay. Further, the Election Officer's investigation in this case showed that Ms. Geyer was properly nominated and seconded at the nominations meeting, and she accepted her nomination for the position of alternate delegate. Her failure to execute her signature next to her printed name on the slate declaration form was inadvertent.
