
Gentlemen:

This will acknowledge receipt of the above referenced election protest filed under Article XI, § 1 of the *Rules for the IBT International Union Delegate and Officer Election*, revised August 1, 1990 ("*Rules*"), a copy of which is enclosed. Pursuant to the request of the protestor, Barry L. Clark, the Election Officer investigated this protest, and set forth his decision with respect thereto, in connection with the appeal filed by Mr. Clark from the decision of the Election Officer in Election Office Case No. Post-69-LU420-CLA. The Election Officer's decision in Election Office Case No. Post-69-LU420-CLA, including the portion relating to the Election Officer's investigation and determination with respect to the worksite list issues raised in the instant protest, was affirmed by the Independent Administrator on May 28, 1991, 91-Elec.App.-152. Accordingly, the allegations of the instant protest, as a separate protest, are moot and the matter is therefore DISMISSED.

If any interested party is not satisfied with this determination, they may request a hearing before the Independent Administrator within twenty-four (24) hours of their receipt of this letter. The parties are reminded that, absent extraordinary circumstances,

no party may rely upon evidence that was not presented to the Office of the Election Officer in any such appeal. Requests for a hearing shall be made in writing, and shall be served on Independent Administrator Frederick B. Lacey at LeBoeuf, Lamb, Leiby & MacRae, One Gateway Center, Newark, New Jersey 07102-5311, Facsimile (201) 622-6693. Copies of the request for hearing must be served on the parties listed above, as well as upon the Election Officer, IBT, 25 Louisiana Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001, Facsimile (202) 624-8792. A copy of the protest must accompany the request for a hearing.

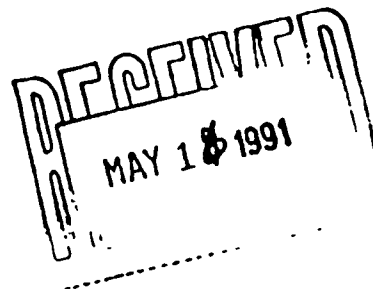
